3. Councillor O'Rourke

That the council carry out a survey and inspection on the R403 (Celbridge to Clane Road) with a view to reducing the speed limit and installing a continuous white line from 'New Road' to 'Longtown' in the interest of safety.

That the Garda at senior level be written to again asking them to enforce parking regulations at Parson Street, Maynooth and that the road be resurfaced and double yellow lines painted on the Joan Slade side, as soon as possible.

5. Councillor McGinley

That a yellow box junction be painted at the Convent Lane/Main Street/Doctors Lane junction in order to reduce the possibility of traffic illegally blocking the junction.

6. Councillor Byrne

That the footpath be repaired between houses (details supplied) Saint Patricks Park, Celbridge and that whether or not a utility company is responsible for the damage be checked.

7. Councillor Neville

That the council look at fixing potholes at the entrance to Ryevale Lawns phase one. If no funds are available, can the council give an outline of the strategy to deal with these types of issues in the long run or will roads especially in estates continue to get worse and worse in the future.

That the council address the concerns of parents for safety measures outside the schools in the Green Lane in Leixlip. Presently the situation can be quite dangerous especially with such a narrow path outside the school.
