Naas By-Pass

Kildare County Council marked the 30th anniversary of the completion of Naas By Pass at a ceremony in Aras Chill Dara on Friday, 4th October. In attendance at the ceremony were, not only those directly responsible for the construction, but also the designers and the administrative staff who delivered this important project.

Naas By Pass was an embryonic step in the motorway network which now links our major cities. The Mayor of Kildare, Councillor Mark Wall, paid tribute to those who took the brave decision to proceed with construction of the first section of motorway here in Naas. Projects of the scale and complexity of Naas By Pass had not been undertaken in the Republic previously.



The Mayor of Naas, Councillor Emer McDaid, said that the town has benefited significantly from those brave decisions and posed the question - what chaos and congestion would have dominated life in Naas had the By pass not gone ahead?

The 30th anniversary function provided an opportunity for those involved to reminisce and celebrate.
