

Kildare Road Safety

Pedestrians:

Wear a high visibility vest or luminous jacket while out walking. Only cross a road when it is safe to do so and never attempt to cross a road if it is likely to cause a vehicle to stop suddenly.

Cyclists:

Give drivers advance warning of your intention if turning. Wear a cycle helmet and be visible to other road users. Ensure front and rear lights are clean, clear and working.

Drivers:

Driving under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs is illegal and dangerous. Don't do it!

Drive at an appropriate speed that is safe for you to stop suddenly or at a speed that is safe for the conditions you are driving in. Always wear a seatbelt and ensure your passengers wear theirs.
