St James church lies on the site of a monastery founded about the year 800 by father St Diarmuid after which Castledermot takes its name. The monastery was raided by the Vikings in the 9th century Following being raided by Vikings in the 9th century, it continued existence to the 12th century. Worship continues to this day in St. James' Church and is open to the public - visitors welcome. North side of the church is a round tower to where it is attached to an ancient arrow and high passage 8 feet length. Graveyard: high crosses with depictions of the crucifixion, Adam and Eve, Daniel in the Lion's Den. The high crosses are among the best preserved in the Barrow valley.
